...General Court, to change the name of the corporation to "The Lawrence Academy At Groton." At the succeeding session of the Legislature, the petition was preferred and granted. In July, 1846, Amos Lawrence, Esq., whose name has already been more than once used as that of a beneficent patron of the institution, purchased the Brazer estate, so called, being the mansion of the late James Brazer, Esq., and adjoining the Academy lot, for the sum of \$4,400; and soon after conveyed the same by deed, to the trustees of the Lawrence Academy at Groton. This conveyance is made upon the following considerations, expressed in the deed. "Born and educated in Groton, deeply interested in the welfare of that town, and especially of the Lawrence Academy established in it by my honored father and his worthy associates, and grateful for the benefits, which his and their descendants have derived from that institution, I am anxious to promote its future prosperity; trusting that those charged with the care and superintendence of it, will ever strive zealously and faithfully to maintain it as a nursery of piety and sound learning. Therefore, know ye, that the said Amos Lawrence, in consideration of the premises, and of one dollar," &c. He also requested the trustees to have all the buildings and fences upon this estate, put in a state of complete repair at his expense. This request has been complied with, at an expense of more than \$1,200. In August, 1846, the trustees received a letter from William Lawrence, Esq., the liberal donor of the ten thousand dollars, before mentioned, in which he proposed to appropriate five thousand dollars to be expended by them for the following purposes, viz. 1. To enlarge the Academy building. 2. To erect a substantial ston...
